Eligibility

A student interested in becoming an Engage NJ Intern must meet the following requirements:

- Commit to a minimum of one academic year, beginning in September 2024
- Be willing to attend one orientation in September, one marketing meeting in November, and the THRIVE conference in February or a regional event
- Be enrolled full-time at an New Jersey accredited higher education institution
- Must have access to a computer
- Must have an eagerness to learn!

Preferably, applicants will also be involved in some form of student leadership but we are happy to take on any students who are new to acting in leadership roles.

Intern Tasks

Please note that we will try to curtail your internship experience to your major, interests, and intended career path

- Work 150 hours (5 hours per week) in one academic year at Engage NJ
- Promote Engage NJ events, opportunities, and news on your college campus
- Act as a liaison between Engage NJ and student organizations on your campus
- Assist with the Engage NJ Team with social media, the Student Success Steering Group, and general ideas on capacity building
- Attend Engage NJ Team meetings
- Learn from the Engage NJ Team about their tasks and potentially assist them with things such as professional communication, grant management, steering group application reviews, volunteer management, and/or social media content creation

- OPTIONAL: Attend Engage NJ's annual THRIVE Conference and give a presentation on your experience interning as at Engage NJ
