- 20 NJ campuses participated in Engage NJ programming and events, reflecting Jersey's geographic, socio-economic, and racial diversity
- 14 campuses guided our statewide efforts through board membership and steering group service
- 1,361 students improved their college completion and job prospects by working in teams on community projects, accessing expanded pantry resources, getting career pathway training, certifications, and more
- 125 students have secured interviews or full-time positions through our VISTA supports
- 219 campuses, nonprofits, and social services improved their operations and outreach as part of our ENGAGECorps VISTA program
 - **389** high school students persisted and built a connection to their neighboring college through near-peer tutoring and mentoring

21ST-CENTURY COMPETENCIES FOR LIFE & WORK

THRIVE Conference and Fair evaluations showed:

- 62% said they developed better critical thinking skills.
- **63%** improved their communication skills.
- **60%** showed improved use of evidence in decision-making.
- **56%** said they have improved how they take responsibility in leadership roles.

JOIN THE COALITION! Here's a snapshot of what Engage NJ and member campuses are working on. As part of the 5-year plan we developed with 14 cross-sector stakeholders on our planning council and constant feedback from members across the state, Engage NJ has set an aim for at least **5,000 students** to complete an educational and experiential pathway that enables them to advance democracy and develop transferable competencies for life and work.

In 2023: 1,361 students accessed quality community-engaged experiences, expanded campus resources, and 21st-century competency training. So far, this Academic Year...
